 - i) B.D.S.- 613 [Govt. – 313 . Pvt. 300]
 - ii) M.D.S.- 91 [Govt. – 33 .Pvt.- 58]
3. No. of Dental Surgeon registered within the State Dental Council. - 9219 (Approx)
4. No. of Dental Surgeon in Govt. Service – 606 (Approx)
5. No of Government posts vacant and those in rural/difficult areas – 44 (Approx)
6. No. of Dental Surgeon registered in employment Exchange: - Not known.
7. Dental Surgeon population relation ratio the State: 1 : 57,000
8. How the establishment of this B.D.S .course will resolve the problem of deficiency of qualified Dental personal in the state and improve the availability of such Dental man power in this state :- . Now new introduction of B.D.S. course will resolve the problem of the State. Such action is absolutely necessary to cope up with scarcity of Dental Surgeon in the rural areas and teaching Dental hospitals.
9. The restriction imposed by the State Govt., if any, on the students:- The guide lines framed by The Supreme Court of India and order issued by the Govt. of India , regarding admission of Medical and Dental Students to the Medical & Dental Colleges will full justification for new introduction of B.D.S. course with 100 nos. seats.
10. Full justification for introduction of B .D.S .Course:-
 - i. To cope with the scarcity of faculty Member in the Teaching Medical and Dental Colleges.
 - ii. to achieve favorable Dentist population ratio in the long run . (1: 25,000)
11. Dental Surgeon - Patient ratio proposed to be achieved ---- 1 : 25,000

12. Copy of the inspection report in connection with the inspection carried out by the State Government for grant of permission for introducing B.D.S. Course is to be attached.

Sanaka Institute of Dental Sciences has applied for establishment of a dental college at Malandighi, Durgapur, Paschim Bardhaman. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of West Bengal has decided to issue Essentiality certificate to the applicant for starting of new course with 100 nos. seats

It is certified that:-

- A. The applicant owns and manages 900 bedded Hospital.
- B. The applicant own and manages Dental departments with Dental chairs.
- C. It is desirable to start B.D.S. course in the public interest; - Yes.
- D. Minimum 30 Dental patient may be available per day to begin with:- Yes .
- E. The credibility of financial status of the applicant has been verified:- Yes.

It is further certified in case of the applicant fails to create infrastructure for starting B.D.S. Course as per Dental Council of India norms and fresh admission are stopped by Dental Council of India , the state Government shall take over responsibility of the students admitted in the college with the permission of the central Government.
